## POST-SURGICAL INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Pain medication-We prefer non-prescription medications such as Ibuprofen (Advil) and Extra-Strength Tylenol, as directed on the bottle, if you can take these.
- 2. Some swelling on the first few days following surgery is not unusual and may increase to the third day post-surgery.

  To minimize swelling-make an icepack using ice cubes inside a plastic bag covered with a washcloth. Apply this to the side of your face-15 minutes on, 15 minutes off, for the **first day**. If you notice swelling the next day you may apply **moist heat**, like a hot washcloth, but not cold.
- 3. Some seepage of blood the first day is normal. Avoid hard rinsing, as this will increase bleeding. Heavy seepage can be controlled by gently pressing a moist teabag to the area. If bleeding is heavy and steady, call our office or the doctor if the office is closed.
- 4. Eat soft foods for the first few days and try to avoid the area of surgery. Also avoid very hot, cold or spicy foods. Do not use a straw for 24 hours after Treatment and no spitting.
- 5. Do not brush surgical areas until OK'd by the doctor. It's OK to brush in the non-surgical areas. If you were given a prescription for an antiseptic rinse, use it twice a day, beginning the day after surgery. Do not rinse today.
- 6. Smoking delays healing and increases the chance of infection. If you are a smoker, please try to avoid or minimize this for the first week after surgery.
